

Creating a case sensitive filesystem on MacOS X

Molcas requires a case sensitive filesystem, which is not standard on most MacOS X installations. To create a case sensitive filesystem, you will need to re-format an empty partition which erases all data on the volume. Alternatively you may use an external Firewire/USB disk or an iPod (this will also need to be reformatted).

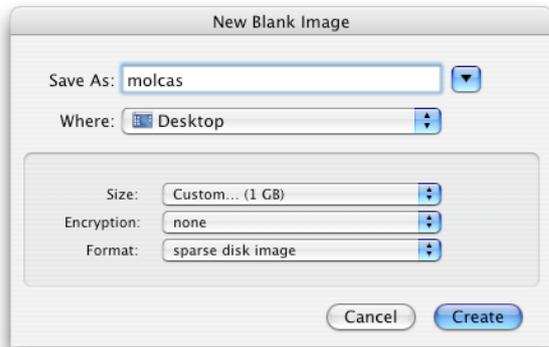
This is what you do:

- 1) Backup data you have on the volume you wish to use.
- 2) Open Disk Utility (/Applications/Utilities)
- 3) Unmount the volume.
- 4) Re-format and select "UNIX File System".
- 5) Mount the volume.

Alternative approach (non destructive)

Instead of installing MolCas on a physical volume you can install it into a disk image. To create a case sensitive disk image do the following:

- 1) Open Disk Utility
- 2) In the file menu, select new blank image.
- 3) The size should be around 1 Gb (?) and the format "sparse disk image".



- 4) Mount the image by double clicking the image file.
- 5) In Disk Utility, re-format it and select "UNIX File System"
- 6) MolCas can now be installed in /Volumes/molcas
- 7) Automount the molcas volume by putting the image in Login items in your account preferences.
